

ACCREDITATION OVERVIEW



DrJ Meets and Exceeds IBC Requirements per Section 1703

- DrJ is an approved agency through our ANAB accreditation according to ISO/IEC 17065, which ensures **Independence** (1703.1.1) and competent **Personnel** (1703.1.3).
- **Technical Evaluation Reports** (TERs) provide the building official with the information required to approve the products (1703.2 thru 1703.4), traceable by product **Labelling** (1703.5).
- **Follow-up inspections** are performed by ISO/IEC 17020 compliant third-party inspection agencies (1703.5.2) which are approved by DrJ.
- **Evaluation and follow-up services** (1703.6) such as specialty engineering and sealed reports are available upon request.

Each accredited certification body is qualified by their accreditation agency to practice product and code compliance services within their specific scope of accreditation, which can be found on the accreditation agency's website. DrJ Engineering, LLC focuses on areas of professional engineering expertise, including building construction within the IBC, IRC, IECC, IFC, and local codes.


